## Overview

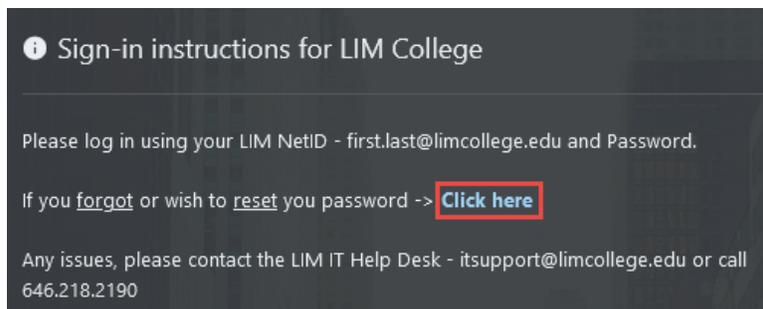

**Note:** It is always good practice to routinely change your password or make them stronger.

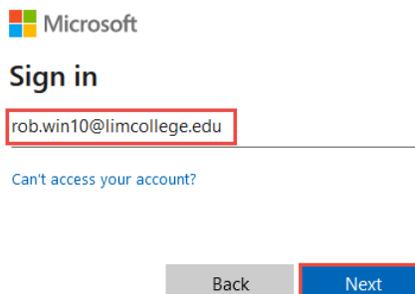
1. On the ‘Welcome to the New myLIM Portal’ page (<https://mylim.limcollege.edu>), click ‘Sign in’.



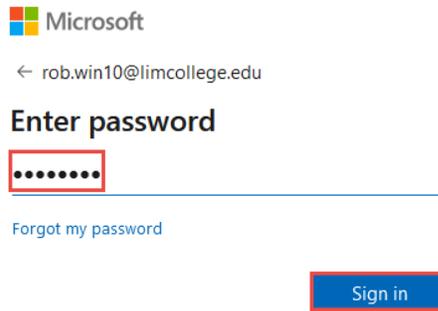
2. Within ‘Sign-in instructions for LIM College’ section, ‘Click here’



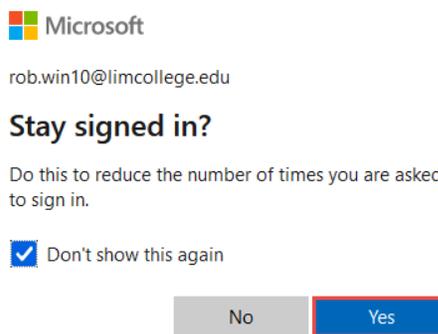
3. You will now be redirected to enter your LIM College email address. Click ‘Next’.



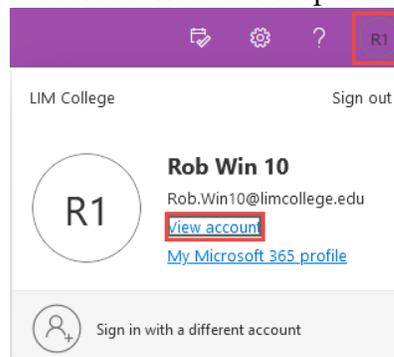
4. Enter your password. Click 'Sign in'.



5. If you choose to 'Stay signed in', click 'Yes'. To not show this prompt the next time you sign in, check off box 'Don't show this again'.



6. Click on your profile icon, then 'View account' from the drop-down menu.



7. In the 'Security info' section, click 'UPDATE INFO'.

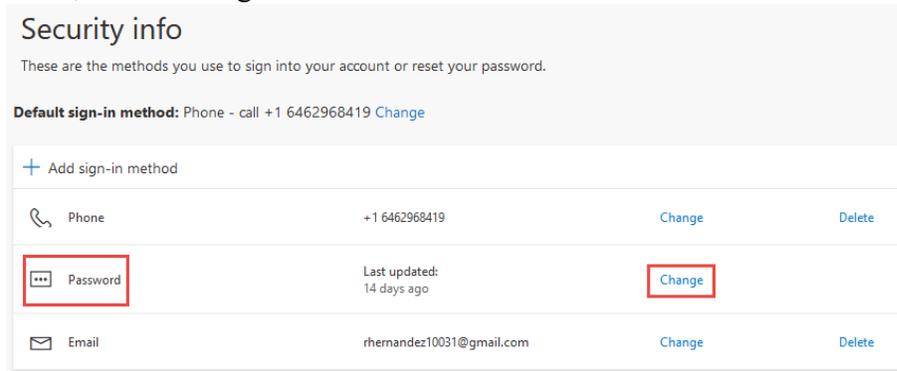

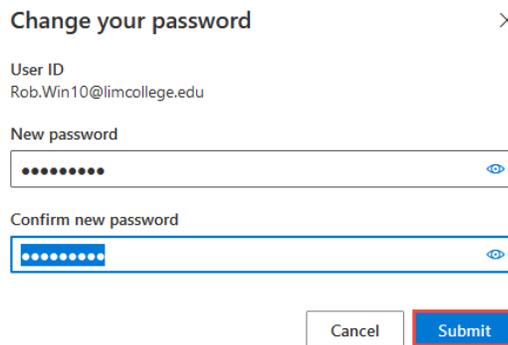
Keep your verification methods and security info up to date.

8. To change 'Password', click 'Change' from the email section.



9. Enter and confirm your new password when prompted. Click 'Submit'.  
**Reminder:** Passwords must be at least seven (7) characters, and include a combination of uppercase, lowercase and at least one number.



10. After changing your password, you will see a message indicating the password was changed successfully. Click 'Done'.
